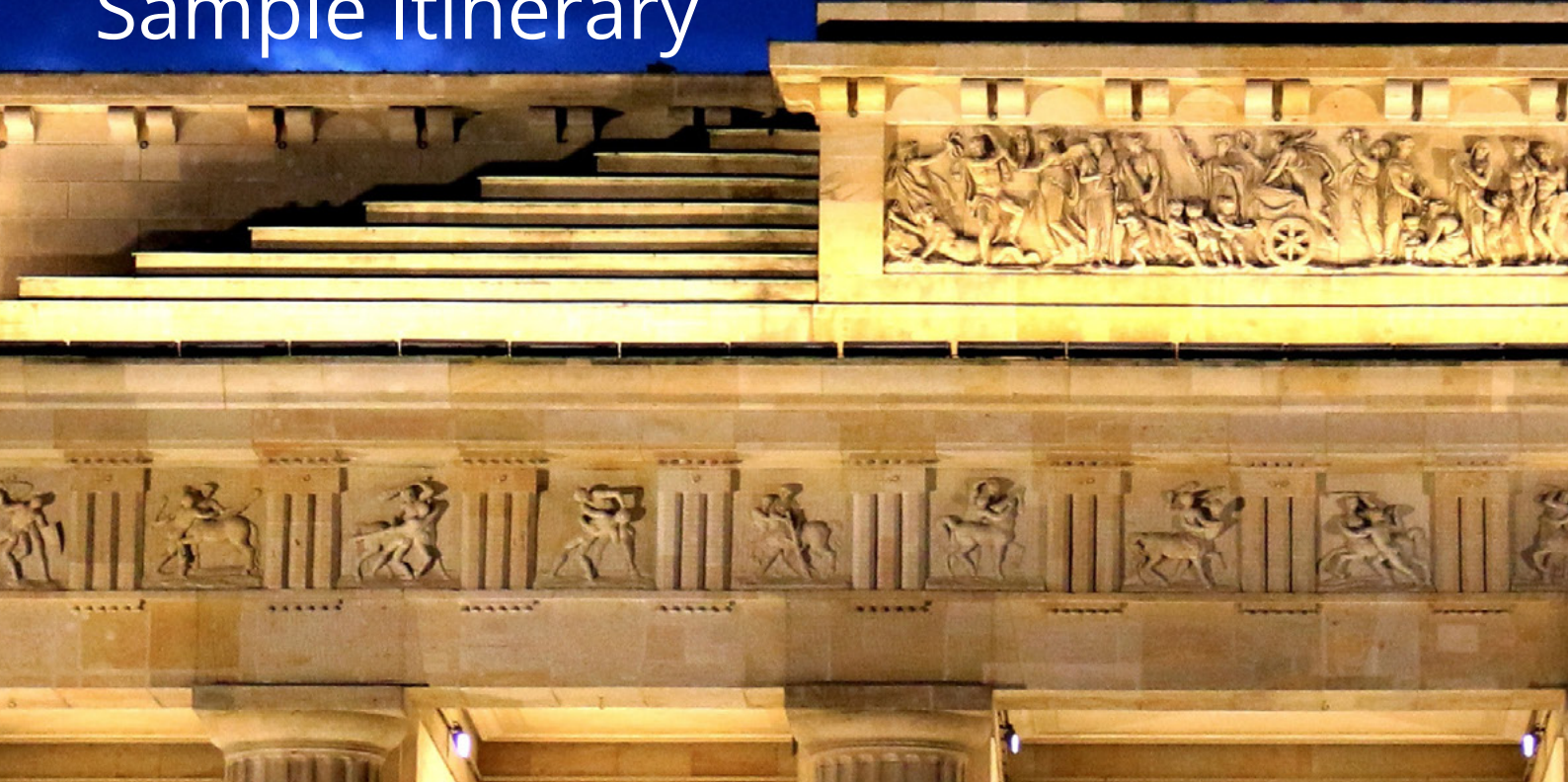

### Berlin Sample Itinerary

#### Day 1 – Arrival

Activity	Description
<b>Airport pick-up</b>	Your dedicated CAS Trips tour guides will meet you at the airport and via private transfer take you to your accommodation for check-in.
<b>Check-in, Rest &amp; Relax</b>	Check in to your accommodation and relax following the long day traveling.
<b>Walking tour: Historical Berlin</b>	This introductory tour of Berlin focuses on the city's explosive history as we embark on a journey through the centuries, with particular focus on 20-21 <sup>st</sup> century history.
<b>Evening Meal</b>	A selection of international cuisine.
<b>Student Challenges</b>	Students will be introduced to the CAS Trips Changemakers Challenge and our Reflection Workshop.



## Day 2 – Creativity

Activity	Description
<b>Street Art Tour and workshop</b>	Students will receive expert tuition from professional street art and graffiti artists and create their own design canvases.
<b>Lunch</b>	Taste wonderful Asian flavours in Kreuzberg.
<b>Sustainable Design Tempelhof Challenge</b>	<p>Hosted by our professional design team partners, students are introduced to the history and incredible community function of the famous Tempelhof Fields and how it was saved from ruin and industrial development to be turned into a public park.</p> <p>In small teams, students must then interview locals and design a community project plan based on their findings.</p>
<b>Evening Meal</b>	Visit a central restaurant and indulge in some delicious foods.
<b>Reflections Workshop</b>	Spend some quality time in your Changemakers Challenge teams and work on your reflections and projects.



## Day 3 – Activity

Activity	Description
<b>The Refugee Tour</b>	On this compelling tour, one brave newcomer to the city of Berlin opens up their heart and world to show you Berlin through their eyes.
<b>Lunch</b>	We finish the tour at the guide’s family-run Syrian restaurant.
<b>Urban Kayaking</b>	Take an exhilarating yet leisurely 2-3 hour paddle down the River Spree, exploring some of Berlin’s most beautiful sights from water level.
<b>Evening Meal</b>	Choose from a range of international cuisine.



## Day 4 – Service

Activity	Description
<b>Service Challenge: Volunteer forum &amp; Refugee Aid Project</b>	<p>Meet volunteers and refugee subjects from one of Berlin’s pioneering NGOs who focus on assimilation and integration. Hear about their experiences, engage in Q&amp;A and discover the day-to-day realities of voluntary work.</p> <p>Following this, small teams of students are tasked with creating and planning a long-term refugee aid project on a ‘Think Global, Act Local’ basis.</p>
<b>Lunch</b>	Enjoy a packed lunch.
<b>Service Challenge: Urban Organic Gardening</b>	Students will come to understand the benefits of community collaboration and environmental issues as they roll up their sleeves and volunteer at a community garden.
<b>Evening Meal</b>	Enjoy wholesome organic food from one of Berlin’s leading eco restaurants.



## Day 5 – Departure

Activity	Description
<b>Souvenir Shopping</b>	Your guide will lead you to one of Berlin’s finest shopping districts where you can enjoy the city’s many fantastic retail experiences!
<b>Airport Drop-off</b>	Your dedicated CAS Trips tour guides will accompany you to your transport terminal and wave you off at the departure gate.
