#### Day 1 – Arrival

Activity	Description
<b>Airport Pick-up</b>	Your dedicated CAS Trips tour guides will meet you at the transport terminal and take you to your accommodation for check-in via private airport transfer.
<b>Check-in, Rest &amp; Relax</b>	Check in to your accommodation and relax following the long day traveling.
<b>Walking Tour: Edinburgh's Old Town</b>	A fascinating introduction to the unique history and culture of Edinburgh's UNESCO listed old town!
<b>Evening Meal</b>	A selection of international cuisine in the city center.
<b>Student Challenges</b>	Students will be introduced to The CAS Trips Changemakers Challenge and our Reflection Workshop.





## Day 2 – Creativity

Activity	Description
<b>Day Trip: Jupiter Artland</b>	Experience Jupiter Artland – a wonderland of sculpture and landscape artworks in the breathtaking surroundings of Bonnington House, a Jacobean manor house within an 100-acre estate.
<b>Lunch</b>	Enjoy a packed lunch.
<b>Scottish Storytelling Centre</b>	Learn about the ancient Scottish art of storytelling that goes back centuries and construct your own stories, to be read out voluntarily at the final night’s Ceilidh.
<b>Evening Meal</b>	Enjoy a taste of Thai food, near the accommodation.



## Day 3 – Activity

Activity	Description
<b>Urban Treasure Hunt</b>	Equipped with CAS Trips mobile phones and an urban treasure hunt map full of cryptic clues, students must navigate Edinburgh’s pedestrian Old Town area in search of clues and answers to the riddles.
<b>Lunch</b>	Enjoy a packed lunch.
<b>The Highland Games</b>	With the spectacular backdrop of the inspirational Scottish countryside, we divide the students up into smaller teams to compete in the traditional CAS Trips Highland Games.
<b>Evening Meal</b>	Indulge in some hearty Scottish cuisine.

Activity	Description
<b>Service Challenge: The Mosque Kitchen</b>	At the heart of Edinburgh’s cultural outreach program lies the wonderful Mosque Kitchen project. We learn about the project and help prepare the restaurant for the evening’s service.
<b>Lunch</b>	Have Indian cuisine at the Mosque Kitchen.
<b>Service Challenge: The Grassmarkets Community Project</b>	Edinburgh’s largest and most innovative community project opens its doors to students who will volunteer in creative projects at the center, working with some of the city’s most vulnerable people.
<b>Evening Meal &amp; Ceilidh</b>	We enjoy a hearty Scottish buffet dinner in the company of the GMP members and prepare for the grand finale of the trip – a breathtaking night of Scottish dancing and celebration in the Ceilidh!

Activity	Description
<b>Souvenir Shopping</b>	Your guide will lead you to Princess Street where you can enjoy the city's best retail experience!
