Day 1 – Arrival

Activity	Description
Arrival and Check-In	Assisted by your CAS Trips guide, we greet you at your transport terminal and check into your accommodation.
Walking Tour of Krakow	A fascinating introduction to the unique history and culture of Poland’s second city, through the UNESCO-listed Old Town.
Evening Meal	Experience some traditional Polish cuisine.
Student Challenges	Students will be introduced to The CAS Trips Changemakers Challenge and our Reflection Workshop.



Day 2 – Creativity & Service

Activity	Description
Alternative Street Art Tour	On this tour we visit some of the city's street art hotspots and learn how to decipher art from vandalism as we also encounter one of the city's biggest problems – offensive graffiti, often the result of football hooligan rivalry.
Lunch	Delicious, delicate Japanese Sushi for lunch.
Service Challenge: Community Action	In cooperation with our local community action project partner <i>aDaSie</i> , students are invited to join the team as we volunteer our time and effort to tackle a unique community service issue.
Evening Meal	Enjoy traditional Polish cuisine.



Day 3 – Activity

Activity	Description
Day trip: Auschwitz- Birkenau	In a private excursion, lead by an excellent official Auschwitz guide, we visit the two-part memorial where 1.1 million men, women and children perished in the holocaust.
Lunch	We stop between tours to eat our picnic packed lunch.
Meet Holocaust survivors	In a once in a lifetime experience in cooperation with the Galicia Jewish Museum, students will have the opportunity to meet with holocaust survivors.
Evening Meal	A hearty evening meal of traditional polish food.
Reflections Workshop	Following the moving experiences of the day's activities, your guide will lead a CAS Reflections Workshop to explore your thoughts and challenges.



Day 4 – Service & Activity

Activity	Description
Service Challenge: Historical Preservation Service	<p>In the Southern Krakow district of Podgórze lies the grounds of Płaszów Concentration Camp.</p> <p>Płaszów is reliant on dedicated volunteers and, in cooperation with the Historical Museum of Kraków, students will roll their sleeves up and engage in a wonderful example of hands-on community service.</p>
Lunch	<p>As reward for your hard work and community spirit, we visit one of Krakow’s favorite restaurants.</p>
Krakow by Bike	<p>Astride the River Wisla and at the foot of the Carpathian mountains.</p>
Evening Meal	<p>We enjoy a wonderful final evening meal together.</p>

Souvenir Shopping	Your guide will lead you to one of Krakow's finest shopping districts where you can enjoy the city's many fantastic retail experiences!
